**Effective 1 January 2023**

**Handicapping System**

The Rumanza Golf & Country Club will use the ***Congu system*** (sanctioned by the PGF) until (course rating) a time that the Club can access the World Handicapping system.

**Minimum Score Card Submission**

- Members are required to submit signed score cards with a minimum of 50% of rounds completed (9 or 18 holes) in any one month.
- Less than six rounds would not be considered and previous the handicap shall continue.
- The Handicap Committee will review the total member rounds at the end of each month to ascertain if the amount of times being played by a specific member. publish its committee finding and report by 5<sup>th</sup> of each month.

**Handicap establishment**

- If a RGCC member does NOT have a handicap, the Member needs to have clearance from the Rumanza Golf coach for playing eligibility on the course.
- For the first handicap certificate, Members will play at least three rounds under the supervision of golf coach and one of the handicap committee member. Who will access and issue the first HC to the member player.
- Once the handicap is established, the member must maintain the handicap as per these guidelines

**Score card Eligibility**

- Score Cards for 18 holes are to be submitted with signature of scorer and player. Marker (scorer) needs to be different for each round, for authenticity of the scores.

**Score card Submission**

- Score cards (signed) are to be placed in the Score Card Drop Box placed at the Club reception.
- Failure to submit the required 50% of Score Cards based on rounds played may result in the member access to the ***Club Golf events being denied***.
- Score cards from other Clubs in Pakistan and Worldwide can be submitted via the drop box system.

## **Handicap Review**

- The Club Handicap Committee will review the previous month's score card submission in the first week of the preceding month and make adjustments to handicaps as required
- The Rumanza Golf & Country Club Membership Handicap Register will be updated on the Club web site and placed on Club Notice Boards

## **Eligibility to Play the Course**

- Members with a valid Handicap Exceeding 28 (Men) and 36 (Ladies & juniors) will have designated days to play on the course on the provision that a member with a valid RG&CC Handicap of less than 28 (Men) and 36 (Ladies) be playing in the same flight.
