Landscaping of course was done by Desert Ink with three themes: Desert, Aquatic and Woodland zones. It is the first South Punjab course to offer Night Golf and a course where you can learn Golf through its professional Golf Academy.

Rumanza has been grassed over with Paspalum Platinum TE Grass to ensure speed and precision, which can resist even 40 Degrees heat without losing its color.

It is truly a world class golf facility.

STATE OF THE ART ACADEMY

It boasts the first of its kind Golf Academy in Pakistan where golfers can learn and improve their golfing abilities. The range is more than 300 yards, Lined with trees on both sides .

NIGHT GOLFING

The Rumanza Golf course is the first in south Punjab which offers Night Golf. The



brightly lit fairways and greens give the golfers a chance to play late in the summer evenings, an escape from the high temperatures of the day.

The light poles are positioned to produce mesmerizing scenery without creating shadows or interfering with the ball trajectory.

Effective use of overhead irrigation using automated irrigation systems which allows us to irrigate at times which will provide the best use of water and reduce losses due to wind and evaporation.

The ability to apply adequate amounts of water-based on field measurements to maintain soil moisture and plant health and minimize water loss and misuse.

The new Golf Clubhouse at Rumanza is under construction. Rumanza launches With a Bang

A big array of international stars attend an impressive inaugural event at the first signature golf course in Pakistan

The Rumanza Golf & Country Club, the latest Faldo Design Signature course, opened its doors last year following a star-studded inaugural on February 26 and 27, 2022 which was attended by some of the leading names in international golf. British golfing legend Sir Nick Faldo was there, as was US Open champion Graeme McDowell from Northern Ireland. They were joined by Spanish Ryder Cup star Rafa Cabrera-Bello and LPGA star Charley Hull from England. Then there were top professionals and amateurs from Pakistan, who were part of the festivities that marked the opening of what is easily the best golfing facility in the country.

Northern Ireland's Graeme McDowell, who won the 2010 US Open, led a list of stars who teed off in a couple of competitions lined up from February 25-27 to mark the soft opening of the 18-hole Rumanza Golf Club.

McDowell was joined by Spanish star Rafa Cabrera Bello, a four-time DP World Tour winner. Leading international ladies champion Charley Hull and Mel Reid from England provided star attraction during the three-day festivities.

Owned by DHA Multan, Rumanza has grand plans for the future that include hosting international Tour events and a world class academy. It began with the star-studded inaugural weekend. There was an 18-hole Pro-Am competition, a clinic by international stars for local youth, a Challenge Match Play contest and a musical gala.

The Challenge Match Play was played on an innovative 6-player format over 18 holes. Playing in mixed gender teams of two, three teams played in an exciting alternate shot, strokeplay format, with the lowest-score team over 18 holes being crowned champions.

Sir Nick Faldo, who signed the Rumanza agreement in 2018 and took a personal interest in its establishment, was pleased with the final outcome.

"This is a landmark moment for Faldo Design and a landmark



moment for golf in Pakistan. We are truly honoured to be creating our first Sir Nick Faldo Signature course in Pakistan and feel a great responsibility for taking full advantage of this parcel of land which, right from the outset, we knew had potential to become a great golf course," Faldo commented at the inaugural event.

"The existing site was flat agricultural land, featuring mango and orange trees, with cereal crops too. We were keen to retain an identity for the site, so we have preserved certain areas of fruit trees





and used them as a feature for specific parts of the course. The site was also dotted with interesting farm dwellings and original earth walling, some of which have been retained as part of the course design to preserve the local character. We have also been careful to preserve the views of the desert, the woodlands and the wetlands to ensure that the course works in harmony with the golf course."We hope that Rumanza, and its superb facilities, including the new Performance Academy, can serve as a source of inspiration for a new generation of golfers in Pakistan, helping to grow the game in what remains a relatively untapped market for the sport, as well as providing an incentive for golfers from all over the world to add Rumanza to their bucket list of courses to play. I will certainly be looking to stage some of my Faldo Series events here, and it surely won't be too long before the Asian Tour and the DP World Tour see it as a potential future venue to host their tournaments."

Cabrera-Bello, who played two rounds at the Rumanza inaugural, was impressed with the course.

"It's a great course and everyone was very impressed. It's fairly forgiving off the tee, but makes you think a lot on the second shot. The greens have lots of movement. Some really deep links-style bunkers around the greens protect some hidden pins. Nick has



always been a fantastic strategist and the beauty of this course is that he makes you think about every single shot you hit," he commented.

"I was hugely impressed with the vision to develop and nurture local talent, especially with the double ended driving range and a short-game practice area with putting greens, chipping greens, and eco bunkers. These state-of-the-art facilities are a first for golf in Pakistan."

Mcdowell, who won the 2010 US Open, sees a great future for Pakistan golf.

"One of things I've felt this week is the passion and the intensity for wanting success in Pakistan golf. What DHA Multan has done in creating the first world-class facility here in Pakistan is that it gives these players the opportunity to play on the type of course that they can expect to see on the Tours. Having had the chance to spend time with the young talent here in Pakistan, it's only a matter of time until these guys move to the next level," he said.



Rumanza vs Raya: An Exciting Contest

The rivalry between golf clubs brings out the best from the players. All over the world, countless matches are played between clubs. Rumanza Golf & Country Club hosted a challenge match against Defence Raya on June 25, 2022. The match was played in the popular Texas Scramble format. In March this year, Rumanza Golf & Country Club, Pakistan's top-notch golfing facility, celebrated its first anniversary by hosting the biggest golf tournament of the country offering a prize purse of Rs12 million. Featuring the country's top golfers, the event highlighted the soft image of Pakistan on international level and helped promote sports tourism in Pakistan as well as in south Punjab.

Young star Ahmed Baig won the coveted title with scores of 70, 67, 70 and 73 and a championship total of 280, eight under par. Other notable performers were Minhaj Maqsood of Rawalpindi Golf Club, Muhammad Shahzad of Lahore Garrison and Muhammad Munir of Rawalpindi. Minhaj finished as runner-up with an aggregate score of 287, one under par.

M. Munir and M. Shahzad were bracketed at the third position with a total aggregate of 289, one over par. M. Naeem (Peshawar) attained the 5th position, M. Ashfaq (Airmen) sixth, Shahid Javed Khan (Gymkhana) seventh, Ashiq Hussain (Multan) eighth, Syed Raza Ali (Rumanza) ninth and Abdul Zahoor (Multan) 10th position.

Race for honours in amateur category was won by Salman Jehangir (Lahore Gymkhana) with a score of 296. Second position went to Qasim Ali Khan, also of Gymkhana with a score of 303 followed by Hussain Hamid (Royal Palm), his score being 310. At a score of 311 were Saad Habib (Rumanza) and Umair Saleem (Garrison Greens).


Rumanza is not just a golf club, it's a place where you can make your dream home

Saad Habib shines in Nomura Cup Trials

The Nomura Cup is one of the most prestigious golf tournaments in the region. Last year Pakistan Golf Federation (PGF) chose Rumanza Golf & Country Club to hold trials to select national teams for the Nomura Cup 2022.

The trials were held from October 7-10 to select the teams for the event in Manila.

Some of the best amateur golfers of the country descended upon Rumanza Golf & Country Club for PGF Trials to select national teams for the Nomura Cup and APGC Senior Amateur Championship.

It was young schoolboy Saad Habib Malik of Rumanza Golf Club who stole the limelight as he topped the trials.

All through the final 18 holes, Saad exhibited high caliber golfing expertise and his command and control can be gauged from the fact that he had regulation pars on the concluding five holes (from 13th to 17th hole) and on the finishing 18th hole he hit a marvelous bunker shot to score an exquisite par. His score of gross 73 on the final day was a fascinating effort and backed by previous three rounds scores of 74, 74 and 71 gave him a meritorious aggregate of 292, four over par for four days plus a masterful first position in the national trials.

In the final standings, Saim Shazli of Karachi got selected with four rounds scores of 69, 77,



73 and 74 and an aggregate of 293 and he lost the top position to Saad by a margin of one stroke. Another young one who made it to the national team was Damil Ataullah of Lahore Garrison who had scores of 73, 74, 77 and 73 and the four rounds aggregate added up to 297. The five aspirants ended up at a score of 301 were Qasim Ali Khan (Lahore Gymkhana), Hussain Hamid (Royal Palm Club), Osama Nadeem (Ibex), Salman Jahangir (Lahore Gymkhana) and Rao Hassan (Rawalpindi). Out of these five, Qasim got selected as the reserve player as he had better scores in the last two rounds.

As for the race for selection amongst senior amateurs, the trials were held over three rounds and noticeable was the fortitude and grittiness between the competing seniors. In the end, Raja Asif Mehdi achieved the top slot while Tariq Mehmood was second, Omar Javed Zia came third and Maj Shoaibuddin was fourth. These four senior champions will now represent Pakistan in the Asia Pacific Senior Amateur Golf Championship.

The Nomura Cup, also known as the Asia-Pacific Amateur Golf Team Championship, is a biennial amateur team golf championship for men. The inaugural event was held in 1963 as a tri-nation tournament in the Philippines when the host nation took on Japan and China.





Rumanza – A Golfing Paradise

It's like an oasis in the desert. It's a 7533-yard, 18-hole course which is the crown jewel of a 9,000-acre community developed by the Defence Housing Authority of Multan.

Rumanza has put Pakistan on the international golf map. It is expected to grow into a leading golfing destination of the region.

The 18-hole course, which also offers night golfing, has been appreciated by all and sundry. Rumanza will also have a six-hole, par-three layout and a state-of-the-art golf academy with a double-ended driving range. By the end of this year, its multi-purpose clubhouse is slated to be ready.

"This is a landmark moment for Faldo Design and a landmark moment for golf in Pakistan. We are truly honoured to be creating our first Sir Nick Faldo Signature course in Pakistan and feel a great responsibility for taking full advantage of this parcel of land which, right from the outset, we knew had potential to become a great golf course," Faldo commented.

"The existing site was flat agricultural land, featuring mango and orange trees, with cereal crops too. We were keen to retain an identity for the site, so we have preserved certain areas of fruit trees using them as a feature for specific parts of the course. The site was also dotted with interesting farm dwellings and original earth walling, some of which have been retained as part of the course design to preserve the local character.





We have also been careful to preserve the views of the desert, the woodlands and the wetlands to ensure that the course works in the harmony with the golf course.

"We hope that Rumanza, and its superb facilities, including the new Performance Academy, can serve as a source of inspiration for a new generation of golfers in Pakistan, helping to grow the game in what remains a relatively untapped market for the sport, as well as providing an incentive for golfers from all over the world to add Rumanza to their bucket list of courses to play. I will certainly be looking to stage some of my Faldo Series events here, and it surely won't be too long before the Asian Tour and the DP World Tour see it as a potential future venue to host their tournaments.

"My design philosophy has a couple of important points. First of all, of course, [is] playability," Faldo said. "We quite possibly will have golfers playing their very first round of golf at Rumanza so I would strongly suggest a lesson or two and maybe a little bit of practice will help set you up for the day. But the important thing is the golf course will be very accessible for any level of golfer.

"The better golfers, we want to teach them the importance of strategy and choice-making on the golf course. And then [secondly], there's memorability. Each hole will have its own design, its own style and maybe its own character and if you've played a couple of them really well, hopefully you leave with some great memories."

The 7533-yard par-72 Rumanza course features four lakes, 49 "eco" bunkers with sandy, wetland and woodland zones. It is surrounded by hundreds of orange and mango trees, making it look like a perfect oasis in an otherwise desert-like terrain.

"We have some fantastic, especially designed eco bunkers that will look amazing at sunrise and at sunset and we have four large lakes that will feature a gradually revealing peninsula. I do feel our landscape artwork in creating these lakes really will add to your visual enjoyment of the golf course," Faldo commented.





Ladies Golf A Top Priority At Rumanza

When Rumanza Golf & Country Club hosted its star-studded Inaugural last year, one of the biggest celebrities in attendance was England's LPGA and European Tour star Charley Hull.

She is counted among one of the best female golfers on the international circuit. Her presence at the Inaugural underlined Rumanza's resolve to promote ladies golf in Pakistan.

Since the Inaugural, Pakistan's top lady players have been joined by many others from all parts of the country at a series of national and international tournaments that have taken place at Pakistan's first signature golf course designed by legendary golfer Sir Nick Faldo.

A brief history of the Golf Caddy

The first acknowledged use of a golf caddy was in Scotland in 1817, and for many years the practice never really extended beyond that small corner of the world, but it gradually spread - first of all at the very top level and later beyond.

In the beginning clubs would hire out caddies to their guests rather than expecting them to employ their own.

It was only in the second half of the twentieth century that it became commonplace for pro golfers to employ their own, professional caddies who would travel along with them around the tournament golf circuit.

Unlike the first caddies, these of course would be familiar with the particular needs of their specific employer.


The Driving Range has separate locker facilities for men and ladies which are available only for golfers.

He has won several titles including Faldo Series Pakistan and Best Amateur of Pakistan Open. He has also represented Pakistan at the prestigious Nomura Cup in Manila and finished at third position in the World Heritage Cup in Mauritius. In an interview, the rising star of Pakistan golf talks about his game and his future plans.

Q: When did you start playing golf and how did you fare at the start of your career?

Saad: I've been playing golf since I was six years old. I started participating in national level events in 2016. My first title came at the Maj Gen Shahid Hamid Golf Tournament at Multan in September 2016. I also won a title in the All Pakistan Golf Championship held at Mangla Golf Course in March 2017. I also won in the 26th Corps Commander Cup at Lahore Garrison Golf Course in May 2017.

Q: You have achieved a lot of success at a very young age. How do you feel about that?

Saad: I feel really good and motivated. But it's a long and challenging journey. I'm honoured to receive the green jacket and represented Pakistan at the Nomura Cup played in the Philippines in November 2022.

Q: How do you see the role of your father and his support both in golf and education?

Saad: My father is a golfer and is always very supportive and encouraging. Sometimes it's very challenging to manage education and golf together as golf takes too much time as compared to other games. Here my father helps me in managing my routine.

Q: Rumanza is Pakistan's first signature golf course. Is it your favourite course?

Saad: It certainly is my favourite course. We are very lucky to have a world class golf course in our country. Rumanza spreads over 270 acres, with three zones, desert zone, wetland zone and woodland

zone. It is a wonderful facility.

Q: Sir Nick Faldo along with a few International stars also visited Rumanza during the Inaugural ceremony. Did you get any tips from them?

Saad: Yes, I got the opportunity of playing with Rafael Cabrera-Bello and Hamza Amin during Rumanza Inaugural Pro-Am match on 26 Feb 2022. There was a golf clinic session with International star golfers. I got tips from Rafa about shots shaping and how to fade a ball with the driver. He helped me in adjustments of some of my body movements.

Q: How important is the role of golf academies for young golfers?

Saad: Golf academies are very important for all categories of golfers in improving their golfing skills. Unfortunately, there is no proper academy for young golfers in Pakistan. Recently, Rumanza started a programme where a foreign PGA certified coach visited Pakistan (Lahore/Multan) for 5 days and gave lectures on fitness and nutrition along with proper coaching classes.

PGF is playing a very positive role while sending teams abroad and giving exposure of competitive golf. At the same time Asian countries have developed a very strong foundation and mechanism for development of junior level golf. Unfortunately, we don't find too much sponsorship in this game.

Q: Please tell us about your achievements at national and international level?

Saad: I have a long list of wins at national level but current year wins are; 12th Pakistan Junior Golf Championship, PGF Trials for Nomura Cup, Best Amateur of 49th Pakistan Open. At international level, I participated in Nomura Cup held in the Philippines and got third position in the World Heritage Invitational Golf Tournament at Mauritius.


Q: What is the role of the Pakistan Golf Federation for promotion of Golf in Pakistan?


